This is an instruction from you to your bank to pay a fixed amount to Wells Cathedral, whether weekly, monthly, quarterly, or annually.

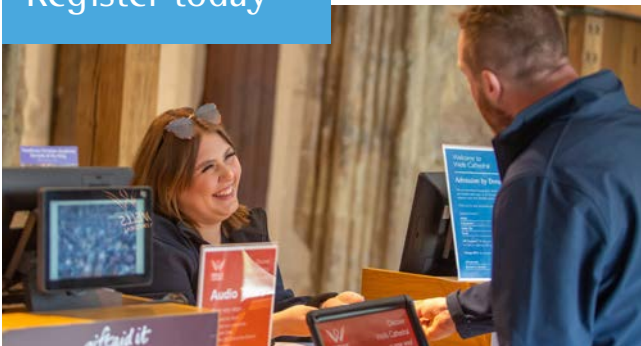
Blue Envelopes

Grow your Gift with Gift Aid

If you are a UK taxpayer, then you can enable the Cathedral to reclaim an additional 25p* for every £1 you donate, at no further cost to you. To opt-in, simply tick the Gift Aid Declaration box at the end of the form.
