Keep your admission pass safe and bring it with you for future visits

1

hour

Join one of the Cathedral's popular highlights tours. They last around one hour and are designed to give you a general overview of the highlights which make Wells unique among English Cathedrals.

hours

Linger in your favourite spaces: soak up the quiet atmosphere of the Cloisters and Vicars' Close, explore the green spaces of the Camery Garden, or curl up with a book in the peaceful Reading Room and Chained Library.

Enjoy a Special Interest Tour and stay for lunch! Open 10.00–16.00 daily, the Loft Café boasts views of the magnificent West Front of the Cathedral and over the tranquil moat of the Bishop's Palace.

hours

Take in a lunchtime concert or stay for Choral Evensong—you'll be made very welcome. It's sung daily at 17.15 (15.00 on Sundays) by the Cathedral Choir during term time, and is the most beautiful enhancement to any visit.
